






in higher education: reduced/targeted government investment; economic rationalization; shift in student identity and perceived entitlements; mental health crises

"LIQUID MODERNITY" WHAT IS DIFFERENT?


- 1. Chaotic cacophony of perspectives

- 8. Echo-chambers, post-truth
- 9. Wider intergenerational gaps, change of intergenerational social contract
